

- Feb. 1: Birthday of <u>Langston Hughes</u>, preeminent Black poet and longtime Mass-goer.
- Feb. 2: National Day of Prayer for the African-American and African Family
- Feb. 3: Feast of Venerable <u>Mary Lange</u>, founder of the nation's first order of Black women religious (the <u>Oblate Sisters of Providence</u>).
- Feb. 8: Feast of St Josephine Bakhita, the first Black woman canonized in the modern era.
- Feb. 11: Birthday of Mother <u>Mary Theodore Williams</u>, FHM, founder of the <u>Franciscan Handmaids of the Most Pure Heart of Mary</u>.
- Feb. 12: <u>Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament</u> founder's day, honoring St. <u>Katharine</u> <u>Drexel</u>'s first vows in the order.
- Feb. 13: Anniversary of the death of <u>Samuel "St. Peter's Sam" Henderson</u>, formerly enslaved man who served the sick in Memphis during the devastating Yellow Fever epidemic of 1878.
- Feb. 27: Birthday of Fr <u>Patrick Healy</u>, SJ, one of the earliest Black priests in America and the "second founder" of Georgetown University.
